



## Room Temperature Procedures

### Purpose of Procedures

The purpose of this policy is to make sure that the correct temperatures are monitored and recorded each day at set times within the play (indoors) and sleep areas.

### Recommended temperatures

All play areas temperatures should be between 16 Celsius-21 Celsius

Sleep areas should be between 16 celsius-21celsius

### How the Procedures is implemented

Digital thermometers are place in each area of learning/sleeping for staff to monitor and record the temperature daily.

Staff must check and record the temperature in the morning and afternoon using the 'temperature record sheet'. If the temperature is below or above the temperature, then action should be taken to adjust the temperature accordingly. Open windows (if too hot) or use fans safely but out of children's reach and inform the childminder to adjust the temperature. If the room temperature is cold, then the childminder will turn the heating on. Seek advice from staff/childminder if unsure.
