



No Smoking Policy

We at Snuggle Bunnies Childcare (Nursery) believes that children's health and wellbeing is paramount in our care. Smoking has proven to be a health risk for children and adults, Snuggle Bunnies Childcare operates a strict "No Smoking Policy" and will not allow smoking in the premises, outside of the premises when children are present and about to be present, at any time. It is illegal to smoke in an enclosed space.

Whilst on the premises or the grounds around the setting, parents are required to refrain from smoking. Staff, students, carers, and visitors must follow these rules also.

Outside the nursery, staff accompanying children is not permitted to smoke i.e., on trips. Staff must not smoke whilst the visibility of the setting uniform is visible as it is vital that staff are positive role models to all our children and promote a healthy lifestyle.

Staff must not smoke near the nursery location, if staff need to smoke it must be away from the setting and out of view from service users.

We respect that smoking is a personal choice, although as a childcare provision we support healthy lifestyles and therefore support staff and parents to stop smoking by:
